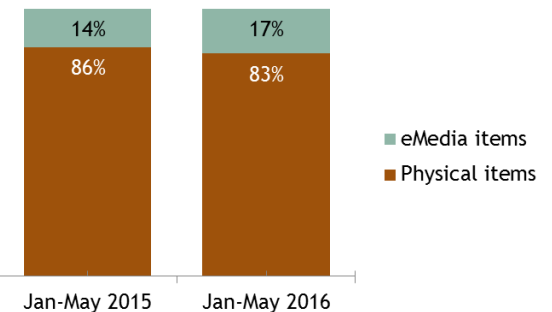

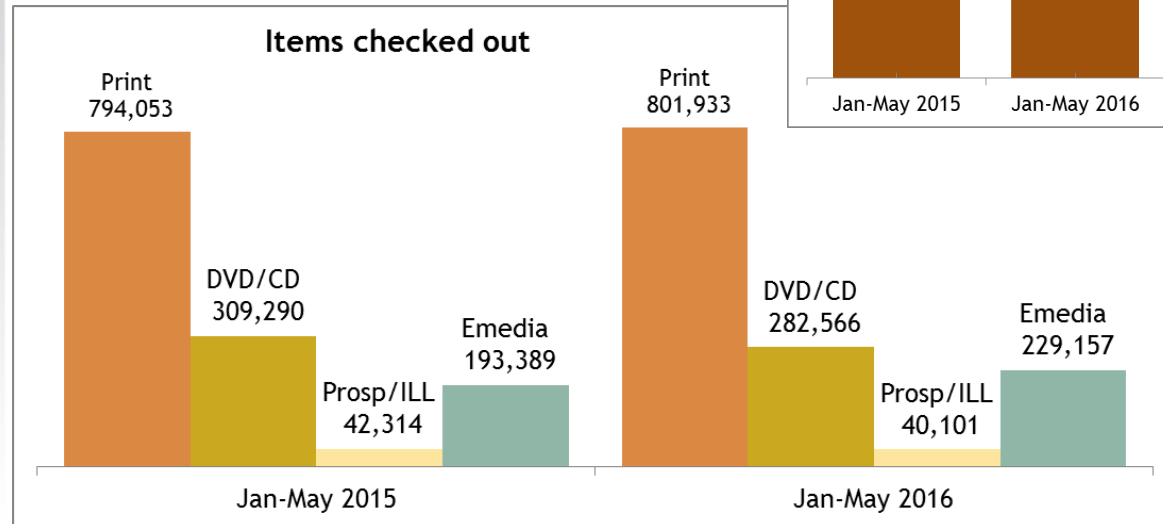

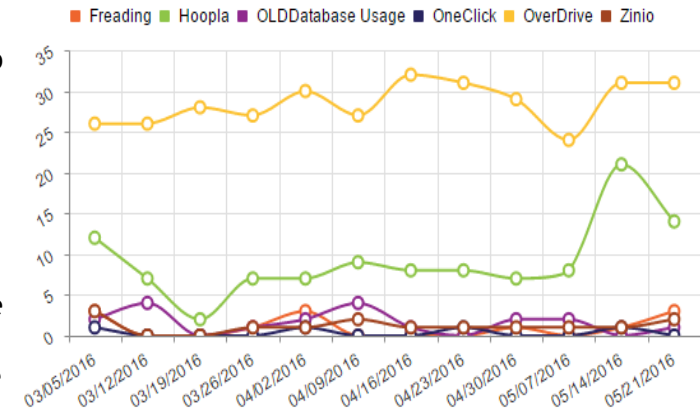

How are the RamCards doing?

In the summer of 2014, the RamCard initiative was launched creating a partnership between PRPLD and CSU Morgan Library to allow students, staff and faculty to opt-in and use their CSU id number as their PRPLD library card number. The initiative also included CSU staff promoting PRPLD digital services not available at Morgan Library.

In September of 2014, almost 700 RamCards were created. As of the end of May 2016, we have 2,329 active RamCards in the system. During the 2015-2016 school year, an average of 114 new RamCards were added monthly.

What's up with all the emedia formats?

The library offers 6 different types of emedia formats for downloading/streaming - books, comics, magazines, audiobooks, video and music. To offer a variety of formats and titles, multiple vendors with different access and payment methods are used:

- Yearly platform and access fee with vendor-supplied titles (OneClick, Films on Demand)
- Yearly platform fee plus additional access fee for each staff-selected title (OverDrive, Zinio)
- Pay per use of vendor-supplied titles (hoopla, Freeding)

The monthly average of emedia circulation is up 19.8% over last year.
