

- If you don't want to see your history, you can hide it from the [Settings](#) page





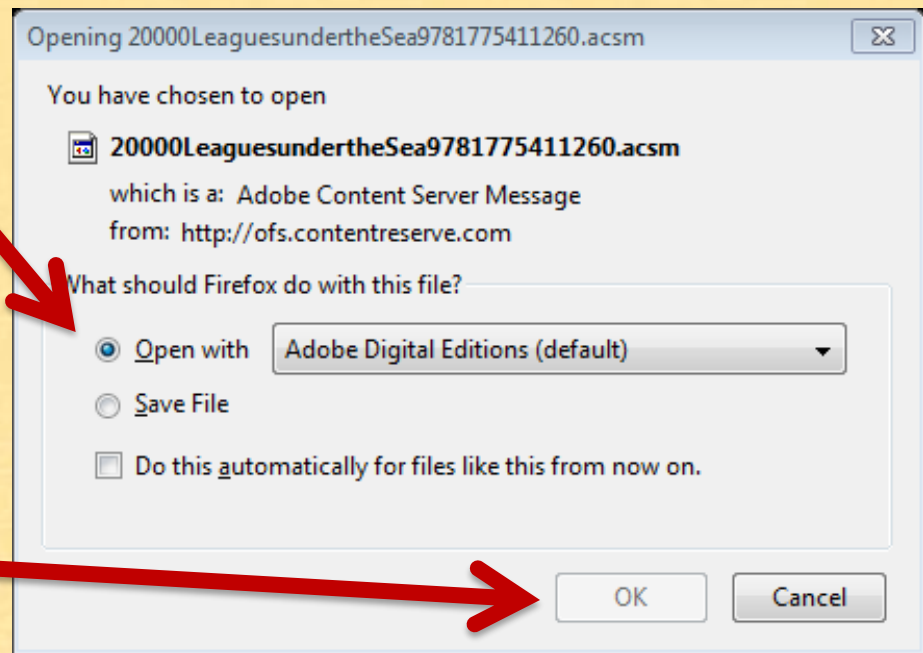


You will need Adobe Digital Editions to open the eBook. If you do not have this software on your computer already, click on Adobe Digital Editions link and download ADE before you click Confirm.

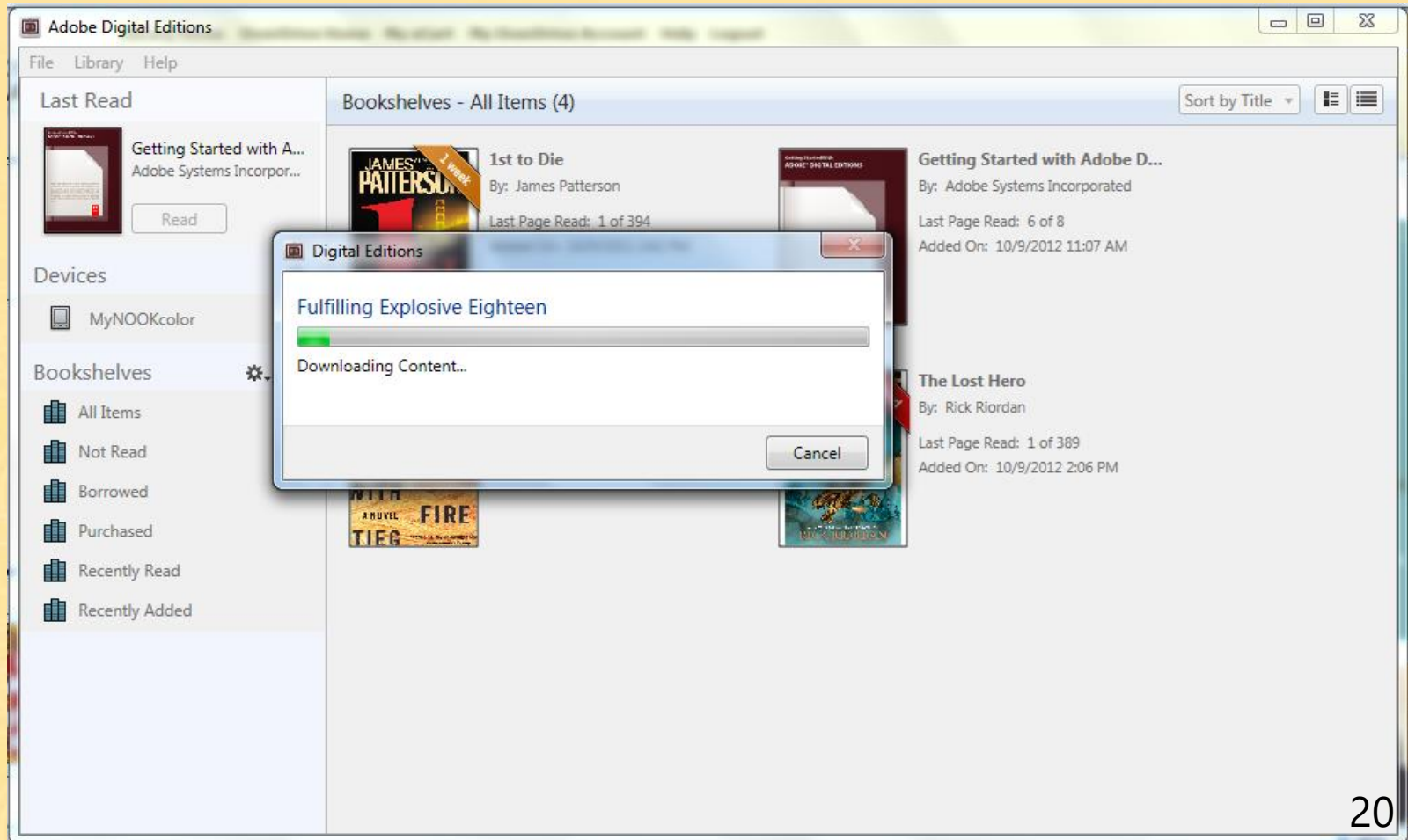


