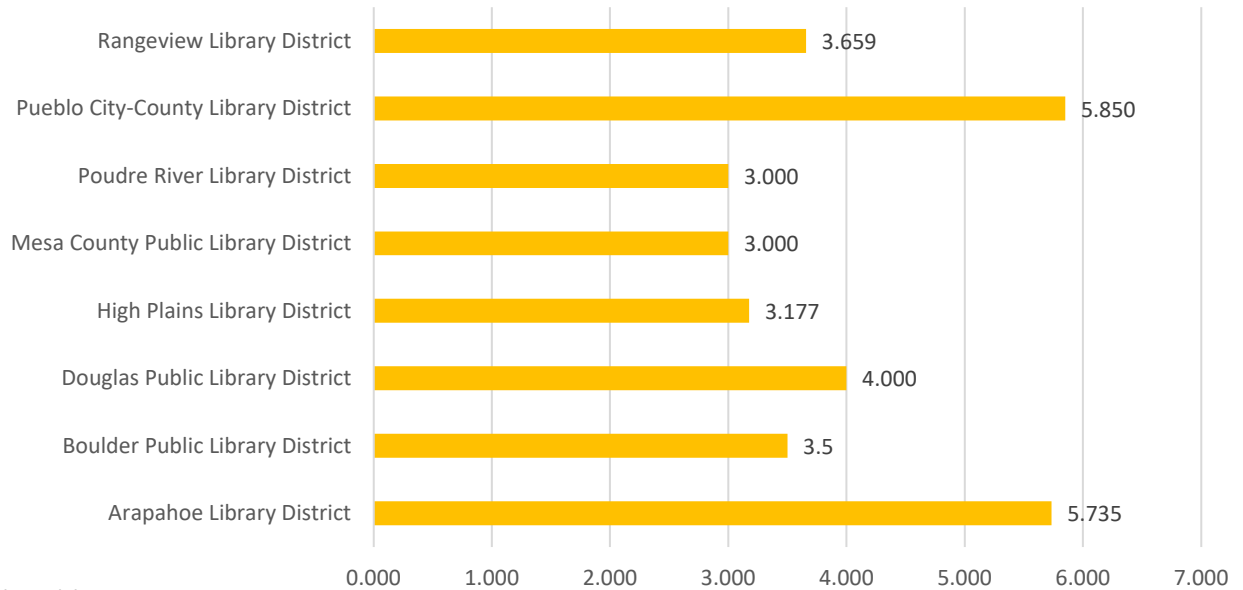


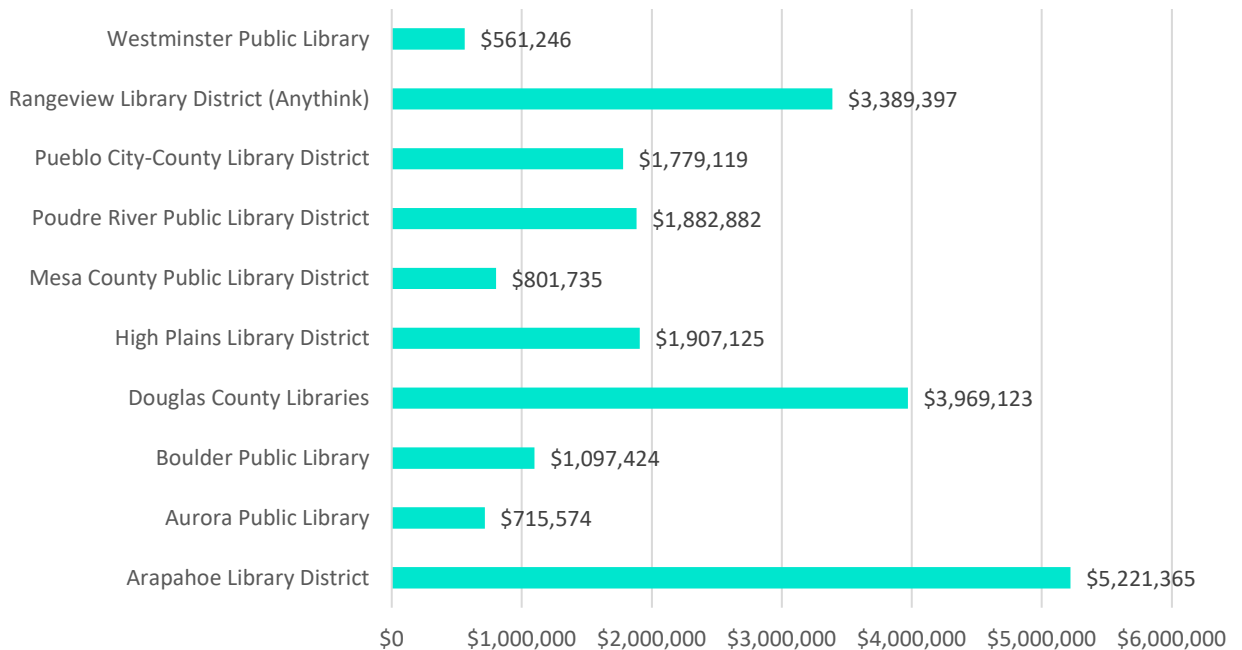
Benchmark Comparisons: General Fund Mill Levy (2022)*



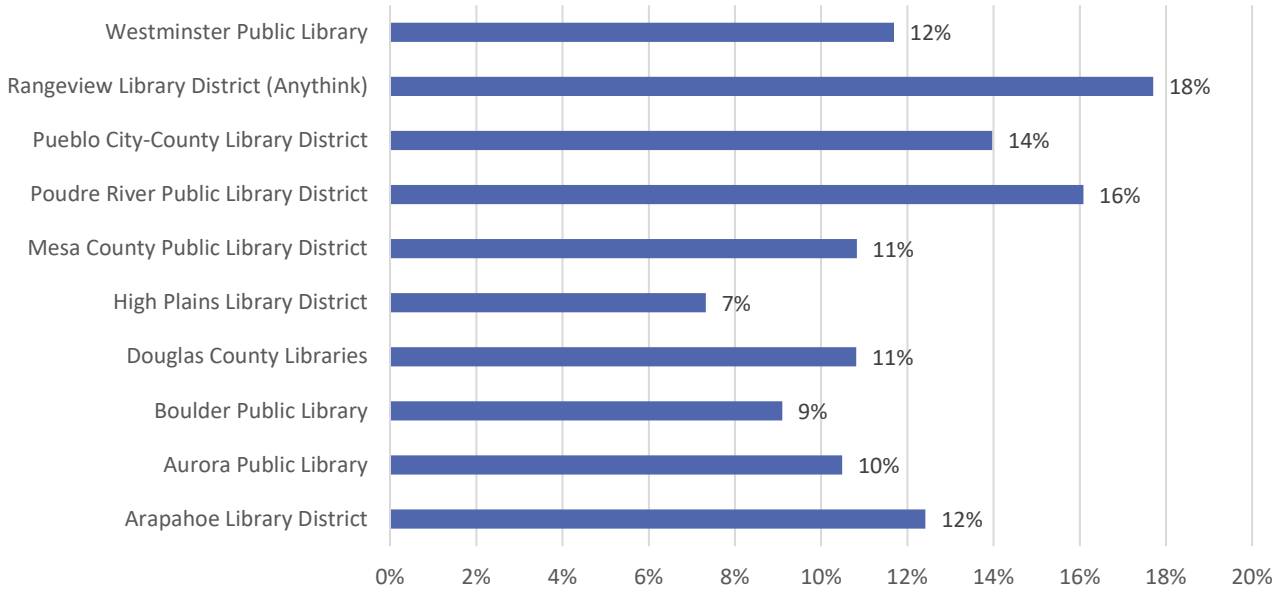

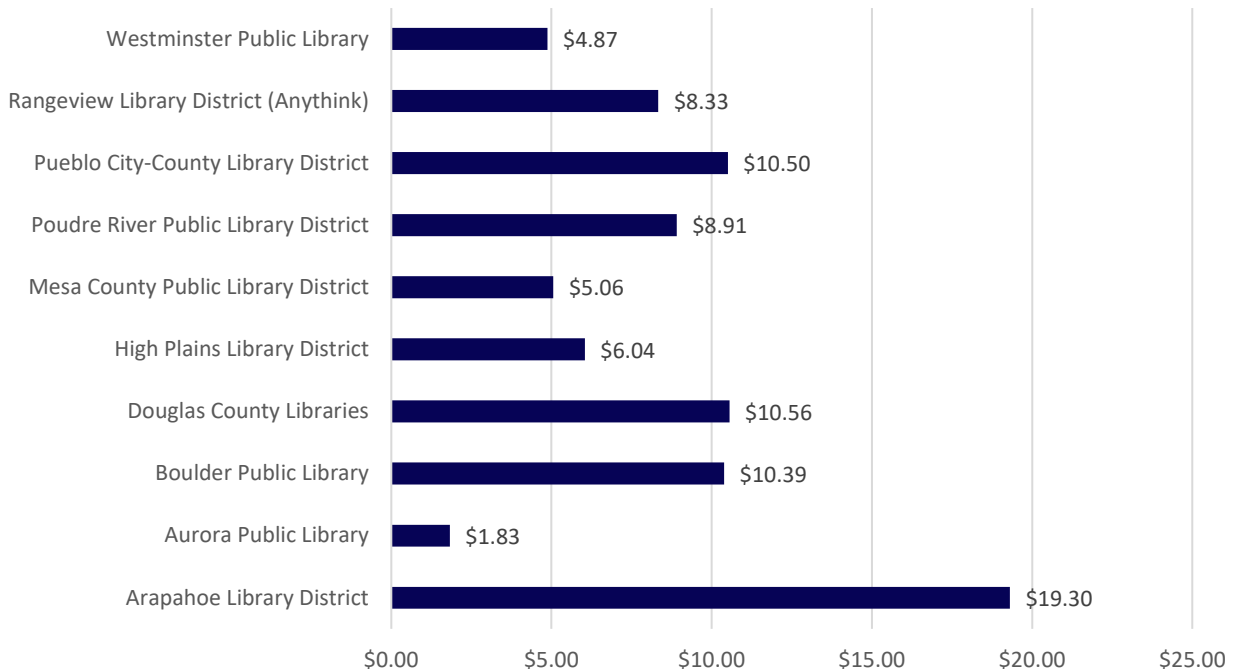
Collection Expenditures



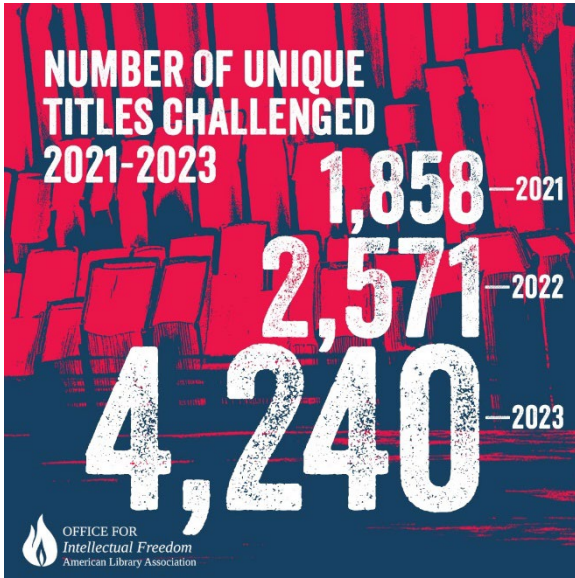
Collection Expenditures % of Ops Expenditures

2024 Banned Books Week + Intellectual Freedom



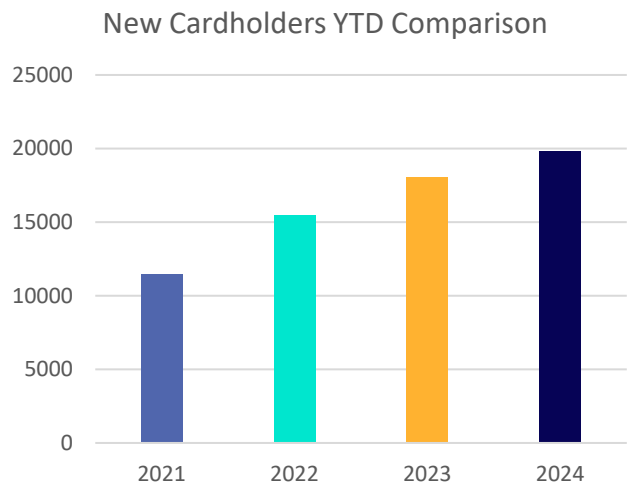
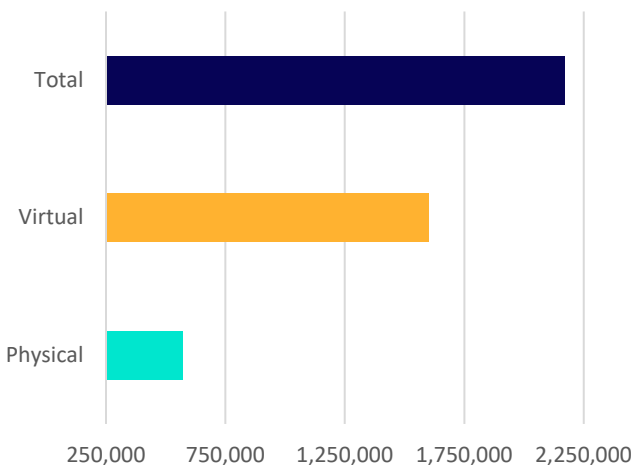
Poudre Libraries highlighted the tenets of intellectual freedom and the right to read through a variety of programs and activities including the Banned Books Week Library Takeover event; "Freed Between the Lines" Reading Challenge; Banned Books Week Bingo at Mythmaker Brewing; in-library book displays; social media posts; popup activities like Dear Banned Author; and more.

In 2023, the number of titles targeted for censorship at public libraries increased by 92% over the previous year, while school libraries saw an 11% increase.

47% of titles targeted for censorship in 2023 represent the voices and lived experiences of LGBTQIA+ and BIPOC individuals.

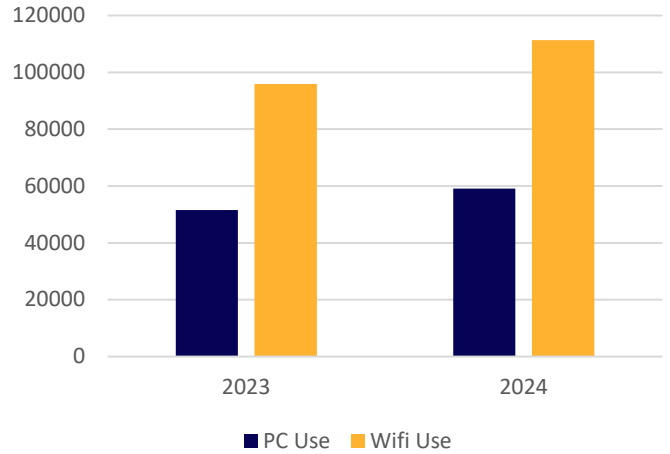
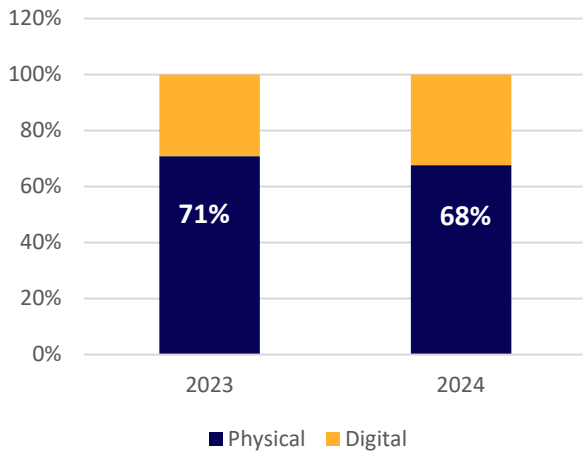
