GOAL 1: Staff Engagement and Culture

- Staff internal communications survey completed.
- Conducted mid-year "Pulse" survey to track progress on areas with low scores on last Denison Culture Survey.
- Toured all library branches and Midtown with Adelante Fellows, with each Fellow giving a tour of their site and sharing what they have learned so far. It was wonderful connecting with staff and seeing the Fellows take pride and ownership of their role at each of their sites!
- Staff Day planning and communications

GOAL 2: Plan & Design an Innovative New Southeast Community Center/Library

- Completed project charter and continue to work on draft IGA with the City
- Received responses to the RFP for design team. Interviews and selection to happy before the end of August.

GOAL 3: Transparency & Accountability

- Board of Trustees new member recruitment began. Applications are due August 15, 2024.
- Policies updated for collections, programming, social media, and reconsideration of library resources to reflect current law and state standards.
- Personnel policies updated to align with City of Fort Collins, best practices, and new state laws.

GOAL 4 Improve the Customer Experience in our Physical & Digital Spaces

- Developed internal pages for new website to improve visitor access to information about library programs and services
- Completed setup of new events and room reserve platform, Library Calendar and working on migrating existing and new events.
- Trained programming staff on using our new Library Calendar system as we prepare for August 15 launch date.
- Public Services Managers and Marketing Manager developed ideas for entry way experiences and updates at branch locations.

GOAL 5 Create a Comprehensive Technology Plan

- Evaluated replacement data servers for staff and public networks as part of the capital replacement plan.
- Preparing evaluation of public print and copy service in advance of copier lease renewal.

GOAL 6: Community Engagement and Partnerships

 Pollinator & Sensory Garden Preview Party for staff, stakeholders, and the project team to get a personalized walk through of the new garden at the Administration Building. The project was generously funded by a Nature in the City grant through the City of Fort Collins. Initial children's programming in the garden also began this month.

- Partnering with Arboretum Coffee to start an in-person Conversations in English meeting at their location in September, twice a month.
- Built a new partnership with Larimer County Jail to provide free books to people incarcerated there. In the existing model, physical books available to inmates are falling apart, and digital materials are available at cost. In partnership with the Friends of the Library, we will be able to supplement their collection with newer titles.
- Front Range Community College set up a scholarship booth at the Harmony library to get the word out about new scholarship opportunities to help people interested in changing careers to update their skills and access childcare while they attend class.
- Hosted "Bereaved Israelis & Palestinians for Peach" program at Old Town Library in partnership with Parents Circle—Families Forum and co-sponsored by Fort Collins Interfaith Council, Heart of the Rockies Christian Church (Disciples of Christ), Our Saviour's Lutheran Church (ELCA), Fort Collins Baha'i Community, First United Methodist Church Fort Collins, Plymouth Congregational United Church of Christ, and Poudre Libraries
